## COMMITTEE REPORTS

### Safety and Rules

The safety and rules committee met in March to do a full review of the existing policy regarding safety and rules for Cedarbrook. The committee was reminded that safety and rules applies to the entire club; the pool, basketball court, tennis court and any event or activity taking place on the Cedarbrook Club grounds. Following a full review, a few changes and modifications were made, but overall the existing policies were in good shape.

There was a good discussion regarding execution and oversight of the policies and members will see some changes this summer. The two most noticeable changes will be the uniformed lifeguards, to allow members to readily identify Cedarbrook staff and emergency drills.

### Finance Committee

A group of members that meet 4-5 times per year to oversee the club finances. They make recommendations to the board on all financial issues, particularly those related to budget and major spending items.

The 2006-2007 committee recommended a dues increase. The board agreed and a dues increase was adopted by a membership vote. The dues increase is intended to be used for the operating expenses of the club (salaries, water, electric, gas, insurance, mortgage, etc).

The finance committee is currently working on two major issues: refinancing the balloon payment on the loan taken out by the membership in 1997 and the best way to pay for necessary major repairs to several areas of the club. The committee will make recommendations to the board, which makes the final decisions with regard to all financial matters.

### Communications Committee

The Communications Committee has been working to improve and expand communications about the Club and upcoming activities. With the help of club members Will Shepherdson and Liza Gully, we are updating the web site ([www.cedarbrookclub.org](http://www.cedarbrookclub.org)). We will hold a number of "Deck Talks" during the summer to share board information and solicit member input, and we are installing a suggestion box at the front desk so that members have an opportunity to offer ideas about ways to improve the Club for all to enjoy. Also, we are developing a Cedarbrook Club directory for use by members. In addition to information on the Club's staff, hours and swim and tennis programs, we plan to include the names, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses of Cedarbrook members. # CEDARBROOK SWIM TEAM 2007

Never been part of a swim team and wondered if this swim team is for your family? Come and try it. This is a great time to start and be part of the 51st year of the Cedarbrook Seahawk Swim Team. The Cedarbrook Swim Team is open to children between the ages of 5 and 18 years old. Head Coach Dave Crocker works with his assistant coaches to assess the swimming level of the children to see if they are eligible for either the regular team (Seahawks) or the developmental team (Kiddie Hawks, usually aged 5-8 years). Afternoon practices start just after Memorial Day, then change to morning practices when public schools are through for the summer. During the summer, afternoon practices continue to be available for swimmers who attend camp in the daytime. On Friday evenings, the team has Pep Rallies for all team members with loud cheers followed by pizza and drinks. Special events are planned through the June-July swim season. Most meets are held on Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings. The Wednesday meets are more casual -- the swimmers often choose their events with some coach input. The Saturday meets are the more competitive meets with assigned swimmers.

I hope all of you are ready for another great season of fun at Cedarbrook this year. I am looking forward to coming back as your Head Pro, and seeing you at the tennis courts soon. We would like to try to have maybe 2 of the Ladies and Mens's 1 night tourneys this year as well as a few mixed doubles round robins. Please be on the lookout for postings of these events.

Please also remember that you must only wear tennis sneakers on the courts, no running shoes or other types of black soled shoes are allowed on the courts. We now have ball machine rental by reservation only, so call me if you are interested.

Please remember to sign up for your courts in advance this year. Except for the pro reserving courts for lessons you can only sign up A WEEK IN ADVANCE. We will have a lot of people playing tennis this year so if you want a certain time you need to reserve it. Also, on Tuesdays and Thursdays in the spring session I will be using courts 1 and 2 from 6:15 to 8:00 for classes. In the summer session I need courts 1 and 2 on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7:00 to 8:30. Please always check the sign up book for the most current info.

Spring Fling will be a sign-up for summer season only. You'll find the sign-up form for the spring session in this mailing, but please call me first (Mike at 301-962-7475) to check for openings and to make sure you're enrolling in the correct class. When I start classes in April it is almost all filled up already as people call me in the winter to sign up and form classes. I am happy to announce Lisa Boyd will teach tennis on Mondays and Tuesdays and Wednesdays again. Please call me to set up or get in a class with Lisa. Cody Powell can start teaching Monday thru Thursday starting early in May and will teach till Montgomery County Schools get out. After that, Cody can teach late afternoon classes.

Lesson Prices in 2007. - Private - \$25 per ½ hr. or \$50 per hour. Semi-Privates - \$15 each per ½ hour or \$30 each per hour. Groups – Per Hour – 3 people- \$22; 4 people- \$19; 5 people - \$18; and 6 people- \$17. If you are interested in private or semi-private lessons, or in starting a group not on the schedule, please call and I'll find a time for you with one of the instructors.
